Mayor's Report

Mayor Kinnell reported that the NCA Board has open positions, and the next Board meeting will be in early October. Had a meeting with Preservation Parks to discuss Galena's trails and bridges, and discussed grants, programs and areas of potential support. Working on gathering ideas for the website and what to budget for 2025, will be starting to build our library of pictures and video. Stover Excavating completed all sanitary sewer pipes and structures. They will be installing waterlines for the next few weeks, and they are currently one month ahead of their baseline schedule. Neighborhood strategies contract has been executed for the Comprehensive Plan.

Administrator's Report

Interim Chief Administrator, Tom Marshall reported that he is working Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) for five years on roads, sidewalks, grounds, facilities, parks, trails and wastewater with a draft plan



presented to Council. He is also working on 208 facilities planning area meeting with MORPC, OEPA and County.

Fiscal Officer Report

Fiscal Officer, Michelle Dearth reported that we received final reimbursement for the playground grant and the General Fund was re-paid the advance of \$233,835.00 that was taken to pay for playground. Working on training Lauren Frank the new Administrative Assistant and the Ohio Auditor of State fraud training needs to be completed by August 31, 2024.
