

**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-05**

**AN ORDINANCE UPDATING THE VILLAGE OF GALENA'S STORM WATER REGULATIONS AS PART OF ITS MS4 PERMIT, REPEALING ANY LEGISLATION INCONSISTENT THEREWITH, AND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Galena is required to update it's Storm Water MS-4 ordinance with new Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) regulations.

WHEREAS, part of the MS4 permit requires adoption of a Storm Water Regulations updates for the permit period 2021-2025.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE OF GALENA, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** That the Village of Galena hereby adopts the Storm Water Management Plan attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference repealing any legislation inconsistent herewith including but not limited to 2020 Storm Water Ordinance No. 2020-05.

**Section 2:** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the Village of Galena which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Galena, Delaware County, Ohio.


**Section 3:** Council hereby finds and determines that an emergency exists affecting the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Galena, such emergency arising out of the necessity to comply with The Village MS4 permit, and as a result, Council hereby finds and determines that this legislation shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
