Ordinance No. 2025-01 (2nd Reading)

Alta Fiber

David Kramer from Alta Fiber presented to Council their proposal to extend high-speed fiber network to all residents and businesses currently within the Village of Galena. With 100% of the proposed construction being buried. They also commit to extending fiber network to additional contiguous areas of the Village due to annexation.

Mayor's Report

Mayor Kinnell's report stated a committee has been formed to "explore" the idea of creating a Joint Recreation District (JRD) for the benefit of our surrounding communities. Working on scheduling a Safety and Security meeting to formulate safety plans for 2025. Mayor Kinnell acknowledged the maintenance team on a great job serving the community during snow removal. The "rough draft" growth and land use plan was delivered to the Village from our consultant and is currently under review. Improvements are in the works around the Village including re-siding the Village Hall, new flagpoles and flags at the Village Square and Village Hall, new flag at the cemetery and new lighting at all locations and new fencing will be installed along Walnut St. in front of the Cemetery.

Council President Report

Council President, Gillian Doucette reported that the Big Walnut Civic Association will be assisting with all Galena events with volunteers. She has been working on the new website with Lauren Frank, Administrative Assistant. She has been working with Mike Fry on the Rules of Council.

Administrative Report

Logan Shannon, Maintenance presented to Council the new maintenance request form on the Village website and explained how it works. Logan and Matt Shock, Zoning also presented the new GIS system that is in the works.

Fiscal Officer Report

Fiscal Officer, Michelle Dearth, reported that all year end reports have been completed and submitted to the appropriate entities. W2's and 1099's have been completed, submitted and mailed out. The BWC true-up report was completed and payment made.
