Minutes of June 24, 2024 Council Meeting

Mike Fry made a motion to adopt the minutes of the June 24, 2024 Council meeting. Josh Porter seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously in a 6-0 voice vote.

Guest Participation

Jennifer Wilson from the Delaware Public Health District was not present but sent information about Summer Clinic Tour featuring a Walk-in Mobile Clinic, places and times available at DelawareHealth.org. Mayor's Report

Mayor Kinnell reported that rumble strips have been installed. KEM is scheduled to start engineering and efforts for the crosswalks at the square. The 55 MPH sign on Old 3C has been moved down towards Plumb Rd. and past Weise Rd. The Historical Preservation meeting on August 7th is a public awareness event for educational purposes only. The Miller Farm bond has been delivered and we received payment for 32 houses first half sewer taps (\$152,000.00). Neighborhood Strategies were selected for our Comprehensive Plan and they will be focusing on land use, growth and development, partnering with our neighboring Townships and Municipalities and implementation.

Gillian Doucette reported that the Playground Grand Opening was well attended. A big thank you to all the volunteers and vendors.

Administrator's Report

Interim Chief Administrator, Tom Marshall reported that he is working on a work-order based system for the Village maintenance, reviewing the road study report and working on a capital improvement plan for funding next year's pavement projects. He is also working on evaluating the Right-of-Way permit process and the Miller Farm Subdivision's site prep and utility installation is in progress, boring is complete, and he is evaluating alternatives for Vans Valley-Joe Walker intersection.



Fiscal Officer Report

Fiscal Officer, Michelle Dearth reported that the final paperwork for the Playground grant has been submitted and awaiting reimbursement. The estimated revenue and levy budget estimate was completed and submitted to the Delaware County Auditor. The MORPC salary survey and OWDA financial information forms were completed and submitted. Fraud training for the Ohio Auditor of Sate is required by all elected officials and staff and needs to be completed by August 31, 2024.


