

Please note that section 29.02 of the Village of Galena Zoning Code regulates the placement of political campaign signs.

- E. Political Signs The erection of political signs shall be permitted in any district of the municipality provided that said signs:
 - Are located outside the right-of-way limits of the road and do not interfere with visibility of vehicular traffic entering or leaving the highway.
 - Are erected or posted not more than ninety (90) days prior to the election and are removed within ten (10) days following primary and general election by both winning and losing candidates.
 - 3. Are capable of posting and removal without destruction of public or private property.
 - 4. Designate the name and address of the person charged with removal of the sign.

Any signs that are in violation of 29.02 of the Village's Zoning Code will be removed and stored in the Village Hall to be reclaimed. Any signs that are not reclaimed within 10 days after the election will be disposed of.
