

Village of Galena Announces Pavilion Project at Miller Park

Galena, Ohio — 9/17/2025 — The Village of Galena is excited to announce the upcoming construction of a new pavilion at Miller Park, located at 286 N Walnut Street in Galena, Ohio. Designed by **BSHM Architects, Inc.**, the project will honor Galena's history while providing a valuable new community space.

Phase I of the project will begin Fall 2025 and will feature the construction of the pavilion's initial structure. The design pays tribute to Galena's historic train station, which was tragically lost to fire in the early 20th century. By incorporating elements of this landmark into the new pavilion, the Village seeks to preserve its heritage while creating a modern gathering place for residents and visitors.

Phase II, scheduled to begin in 2026, will expand the pavilion's functionality with the addition of utilities, including water, electric, and sewer. This phase will also introduce restrooms and other amenities, making the pavilion a fully equipped venue for community events, recreation, and gatherings.
